[Young Professionals in Foreign Policy \(YFPF\) Tokyo](#) is pleased to invite abstract submissions for the second **International Conference on Human Rights**, which is to be held both online and in-person in **March 2024**. The in-person event will be held on the **Komaba Campus of the University of Tokyo**. The 2024 ICHR Conference aims to offer an international, intergenerational, and inclusive opportunity for students and young scholars to engage with contemporary human rights topics and cultivate youth involvement in the collective advancement of human rights. This conference further aims to present a space that places Asian human rights topics at the center of discussion with the ultimate goal of encouraging young people to join discussions of human rights issues closer to the Asian public.

General Guidelines for Submission:

- Those submitting abstracts should complete the [Submission of Abstracts Form](#), including an abstract of between 500 and 800 words. Full-length papers or multimedia submissions will not be considered in place of an abstract.
- Abstracts will be unique to each submission, but it is generally recommended that the content include an introduction, summary of methodology and findings, as well as a

conclusion. If the nature of your research does not align with this format, be sure to emphasize the main objectives and relevant components of your research.

- Abstracts may be submitted in either English or Japanese.
- Priority will be given to abstracts that showcase original research and academic rigor.
- Applicants are not required to register as members of YFPF Tokyo to submit an abstract, however, those selected as presenters will be asked to register as members of YFPF Tokyo prior to the date of the conference (Note: students are not required to pay membership fees).
- By submitting your abstract to YFPF Tokyo, you have agreed to our terms, conditions, and privacy policies. Applicants must also be aware that accepted abstracts may be digitally published by YFPF Tokyo for the conference.
- Given that this event will be held in a hybrid format, accepted applicants may freely choose whether to join the conference in person or online. However, we strongly encourage participants to join us in person.

YFPF Tokyo encourages young scholars of all academic backgrounds to submit their abstracts featuring original research in Asian human rights issues using the [Submission of Abstracts Form](#) by **31 January 2024** for consideration. Accepted applicants will be contacted at their provided email address within 3 weeks of the deadline.

Terms and Conditions:

By submitting an abstract to the 2024 International Conference for Human Rights, the applicant agrees to all of the following terms and conditions:

The applicant agrees that they are submitting their own original work. Plagiarism of any kind is not tolerated. If the applicant submits an abstract on behalf of an organization or cohort of authors, the applicant agrees that they have received the consent of any and all previous co-authors to submit and represent their work.

The applicant also agrees to materially confine their presentation to the contents provided by their abstract if selected to present. If the applicant wishes to remove their abstract from consideration, they must do so, in writing, no less than two weeks prior to the conference dates.

The applicant understands that the contact information provided is their own and consents to be contacted by YFPF Tokyo 2024 ICHR taskforce members about the status of their abstract and presentation.

The applicant permits YFPF Tokyo to digitally publish submitted abstracts in official event proceedings for the conference. YFPF Tokyo will publish submitted abstracts in full as provided by the author(s). YFPF Tokyo is not responsible for spelling and language errors in the submitted abstracts. The author(s) of the abstract agree that they are the sole owners of, or have all necessary rights to submit the abstract for publication by YFPF Tokyo and the 2024 ICHR organizers, and that publication of the abstract does not infringe any intellectual property rights of any third parties.
